SUBJECT: HEAVY DUTY RADIATOR FOR LATER INSTALLATION OF AIR CONDITIONER.

At the request of the Sales Department, the following Heavy Duty Radiators have been released as optional equipment for vehicles not equipped with Air Conditioning at the factory. This will allow local installation of air conditioners at a later date without changing radiators.

B/M Grp. C-232 701088 Radiator - 6 Cyl. Eng.  
B/M Grp. C-232.1 701090 Radiator - 8 Cyl. Eng.

Also, it would be advisable for Sales Department to specify a Heavy Duty alternator on these vehicles. This is a req'd. option with air cond. and was set-up previously.
